



This new experimental website, dubbed "Federal Register 2.0" presents the *Federal Register* as a daily web newspaper, with a clear layout and useful tools to guide readers to popular topics and the most relevant documents.

The Federal Register 2.0 prototype will be an unofficial, informational resource until the Administrative Committee of the Federal Register issues a regulation to grant it official legal status.

The sidebar also lists documents by popularity and related topic. A rich set of news feed subscriptions are offered, including alerts for rules defined as "significant" under Executive Order 12866.

SUBMIT A FORMAL COMMENT

**SUMMARY** The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (hereinafter Service or we) is proposing to establish the 2010-11 early-season hunting regulations for certain migratory game birds. We annually prescribe frameworks, or outer limits, for dates and times when hunting may occur and the maximum number of birds that may be taken and possessed in early seasons. Early seasons may open as early as September 1, and include seasons in Alaska, Hawaii, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands. These frameworks are necessary to allow State selections of specific final seasons and limits and to allow recreational harvest at levels compatible with population status and habitat conditions. This proposed rule also provides the final regulatory alternatives for the 2010-11 duck hunting seasons.

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), formerly the Federal Aviation Agency, was established by the Federal Aviation Act of 1958 (71 Stat. 730). The agency became a component of the Department of Transportation in 1967 pursuant to the Department of Transportation Act (49 U.S.C. 106). The mission of the FAA is to regulate civil aviation and U.S. commercial space transportation, maintain and operate air traffic control and navigation systems for both civil and military aircraft, and develop and administer programs relating to aviation safety and the National Airspace System.
